WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has historically been a leader in guaranteeing freedom from discrimination for all its citizens; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Department of Human Rights has, since its inception in 1967, worked to prevent and eliminate unlawful discrimination through education and enforcement of the Human Rights Act; and

WHEREAS: December 10 has been declared world-wide as International Human Rights Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, December 10, 1983, to be

HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I encourage all citizens of our state to work to preserve and enhance human rights for all Minnesotans.
