


I, the undersigned, the duly elected, qualified and acting chief magistrate of the City of Willmar, known and designated under its charter as its mayor, do hereby certify that at a special election in and for said City of Willmar called for that purpose and held on the 10th day of August, 1926, the following proposed amendment to Section 206 of the Charter of said City of Willmar was ratified and adopted:-

"Sec. 206. The Council shall have power, throughout the city, or in such districts as it shall designate, to sprinkle either ~~with~~ water or with crude oil, the streets, highways, and public places of said city, or to treat the same by applying thereto calcium chloride or some other substance with just laying proper- ties, as the city council in their discretion may determine and direct, and to assess the whole or any part of the cost of the same upon adjacent property."
