



Proclamation


- WHEREAS: The high technology/data processing industry is deeply involved in furthering the development of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/data processing companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for, the State of Minnesota and its citizens; and
- WHEREAS: High technology/data processing education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Three professional organizations, the Data Processing Management Association, Association of Computing Machinery and Association of Systems Management, promote the interests of the industry and the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the high technology/data processing industry will be achieved by the upcoming 22nd annual Northwest Computer Vendor Show and 7th annual Minnesota Joint Computer Conference; and
- WHEREAS: These two events, known jointly as UPDATA '85, will bring together approximately 100 major Minnesota companies, 150 exhibit and 6,000 professional data processing and corporate management personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, March 28 and Friday, March 29, 1985, to be

in Minnesota, in recognition of the contributions of the Northwest Computer Vendor Show, the Minnesota Joint Computer Conference, the participating organizations and companies and the high technology/data processing community.
