WHEREAS: The North Central Region V Regional Meeting of the American Business Women's Association will be held in Rochester, Minnesota, June 7-9, 1985; and

WHEREAS: The American Business Women's Association is an educational association devoted to the promotion of the professional, educational, cultural, and social advancement of business women; and

WHEREAS: There are more than 110,000 active members in over 2000 chapters of this organization throughout the country; and

WHEREAS: Chapters in Minnesota sponsor local educational scholarships annually, and join with other chapters throughout the United States in providing scholarships totaling more than two and one-half million dollars per year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 4 through June 9, 1985, to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to take proper cognizance thereof.
