



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The membership of the North Star Chapter of the International Conference of Building Officials is comprised of building officials of the various cities and counties of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: It is the responsibility of building officials to administer the state construction codes, adopted by the cities and counties concerned with providing a minimum measure of protection for the health, safety and general welfare of the people afforded by these codes; and

WHEREAS: The General public served by these officials is often not clearly informed of the activities necessary in administering the construction codes; and

WHEREAS: The failure of the general public to recognize the purpose of construction codes adopted and administered by these cities and counties often serves to impede the efforts of the building inspection departments; and

WHEREAS: Public information about the activities of the building inspection departments will serve not only to facilitate the work of these inspectors, but also assist the building official in assuring protection of the health, safety, and general welfare of the general public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 14 through April 20, 1985, to be

BUILDING SAFETY WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge citizens to be aware of the role the building officials play in protecting the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
