WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota seeks to develop a world-class center for medical science and healthcare technologies, known as "Medical Alley," which will foster a link between education, research, business, finance, manufacturing and marketing; and

WHEREAS: The Society for Biomaterials has been organized with the purpose of promoting advances in biomedical materials research and development by encouragement of cooperative research, educational programs and clinical and professional standards in the biomedical field; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 29th to be
