WHEREAS: The citizens of Munich, Federal Republic of Germany, and the State of Minnesota of the United States of America, are seeking avenues of closer cooperation and understanding; and

WHEREAS: The governments of the Federal Republic of Germany and the United States of America, together with prefectural and state governments in both nations, support such cooperation and endeavors; and

WHEREAS: A number of organizations concerned with economic and trade relations, academic and cultural exchange, civic and service clubs, associations and businessmen have sponsored a concert performance by the Minnesota State Band, Minnesota's official band, in recognition of these close cultural and ethnic ties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 5, 1986, to be
