WHEREAS: Since 1950, the Minnesota Jaycees has sponsored the Ten Outstanding Young Minnesotans Program; and

WHEREAS: This program has provided recognition for young Minnesotans, male and female between the ages of 18 and 36, who have provided outstanding service within the state; and

WHEREAS: The program, in recognizing those who are emerging leaders of the state, can motivate them to further positive action, which is demonstrated by the fact that former honorees have gone on to be the vice president, senators, governors, major corporate executives, and inspirational community leaders; and

WHEREAS: By providing a forum for these emerging leaders to have their stories told, others may be motivated to emulate their accomplishments, thereby multiplying the common good for the state;
