
WHEREAS: George Griebenow has given tirelessly of himself in organizing and recognizing the accomplishments of others;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 11, 1987, to be


GEORGE GRIEBENOW DAY
