- WHEREAS: The University Film Society has sponsored public appearances by the world's best known filmmakers and critics including Josef von Sternberg, Nicholas Ray, Jean-Luc Godard, Robert Altman and Andy Warhol; and
- WHEREAS: University Film Society founder and program director Al Milgrom has become the state's leading authority and exponent of foreign films and has contributed invaluable to the cause of international education; and
- WHEREAS: The University Film Society has brought international cinema to audiences of all ages and to communities throughout the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The University Film Society's Rivertown International Film Festival, winner of the 1986 Mayors Public Art Award, has become the Midwest showcase for the best current cinema;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the days of the Rivertown International Film Festival--April 24 through May 10--to be
