WHEREAS: The Angelettes dance group for Stage Door of Performing Arts, under the direction of Sue Anderson, are making a good will tour to Russia, to participate in the International Youth Culture Exchange Program; and

WHEREAS: The Angelettes dance group was selected for this program because of their previous quality performances in other countries and their receipt of top honors in national competition; and

WHEREAS: Participation in the Angelettes dance group provides each dancer the opportunity to share their special talent, and to develop personality, self-esteem, confidence and courage; and

WHEREAS: To excel at this level, a young person must demonstrate, in addition to a great deal of natural ability, an outstanding spirit of dedication, enthusiasm and hard work; and

WHEREAS: On this trip the hospitality and many acts of friendship which will be demonstrated by the residents of Russia to these young citizens of your state are deeply appreciated by all our citizens; and

WHEREAS: The emphasis of this trip is the opportunity afforded the dancers to share a part of our culture by interacting with other cultures; and

WHEREAS: This worthwhile program will bring young people and adults from the two countries together in a common bond of international friendship, and the opportunity to share their common interest in dance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 25--the first day of the Angelettes trip--to be

in Minnesota.
