WHEREAS: October 10, 1987, marks the 76th anniversary of the founding of the Republic of China; and

WHEREAS: Many of our citizens of Chinese ancestry will join with the Republic of China in celebration of the event known as the Double Tenth Day; and

WHEREAS: For many years there have been strong ties of friendship between the Republic of China and the United States; and

WHEREAS: Our hand of friendship is extended to the Republic of China in honor of those citizens who contribute so much to the economies and civic lives of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudolph G. Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 10 to be

CHINESE DOUBLE TENTH DAY

in Minnesota.
