WHEREAS: Home Delivered Meals saves tax dollars by keeping elderly and disabled people in their homes rather than in more costly institutions; and

WHEREAS: Community-based Home Delivered Meals makes possible the joint use of public and private funds and resources to serve elderly and disabled people; and

WHEREAS: The dedication of thousands of volunteers who deliver meals ensures the well being of so many elderly and disabled people; and

WHEREAS: The Aged are revered members of our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 20-26, 1988 to be

HOME DELIVERED MEALS WEEK

in Minnesota.
