WHEREAS: The Fiber Arts being produced in the region include weaving, surface design, quilting, embroidery, basketry, handmade paper, and leather; and

WHEREAS: FIBERS MINNESOTA is a juried show and sale organized by The Minnesota Crafts Council, Weavers Guild of Minnesota, Minnesota Quilters, and Surface Design Minnesota as a showcase for the high quality work being produced in Fibers Arts; and

WHEREAS: FIBERS MINNESOTA will take place at Calhoun Square in Uptown Minneapolis on October 29 and 30, 1988;


