- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Multiple Sclerosis Society is holding its seventh annual Volunteer Recognition Party -- "A Night of A Million Stars" on April 18, 1988 to honor its volunteers; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Multiple Sclerosis Society is a non-profit agency whose purpose is to raise money, fund research and provide services for people in Minnesota with Multiple Sclerosis; and
- WHEREAS: Services the agency provides include counseling, support groups, therapeutic recreation, including aquatics programs and summer camp, informing the public about Multiple Sclerosis and purchasing equipment for people with Multiple Sclerosis; and
- WHEREAS: There are 1900 Multiple Sclerosis Society volunteers in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: It is fitting that the Multiple Sclerosis Society sets aside a time to recognize the hard work, time and energy that these volunteers contribute to the Minnesota Multiple Sclerosis Society, including helping with fund-raising, doing clerical work, providing one-on-one assistance for people with Multiple Sclerosis and helping with other agency services;
