



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The ice sport of Bandy provides recreational, athletic and cultural opportunities for some 500,000 players worldwide; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is the home of the American Bandy Association and the Minnesota Bandy Federation and the center of Bandy in the United States; and

WHEREAS: The fifth annual North American Bandy Cup will be held at the bandy rinks in Edina and Roseville with five United States teams, Vesta from Finland, and Kungälv and Borlänge from Sweden competing this December 29-31; and

WHEREAS: The players and leaders of these teams compete on the ice as true sportsmen, and come together off the ice in friendship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, December 29 through Saturday, December 31, 1988 to be

MINNESOTA BANDY DAYS

in Minnesota.
