



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is recognized as a national leader in harvested acres of vegetables with over 200,000 acres; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota processes more sweet corn than any other state, and is second in the production of peas, plus is a leading supplier of other quality canned vegetables for the nation; and

WHEREAS: Fifteen vegetable processors operate 25 processing plants throughout the state; and

WHEREAS: During the peak of the canning season, Minnesota processors employ over 11,000 people and pay over \$106 million in wages and salaries annually, and purchase nearly \$65 million worth of vegetables from farmers each year; and


WHEREAS: The value of Minnesota vegetables in cans sold to retail grocers and food service outlets exceeds \$260 million;
