WHEREAS: Through these records, dairy farmers can tell which cows in their herd give them the best economical return; and

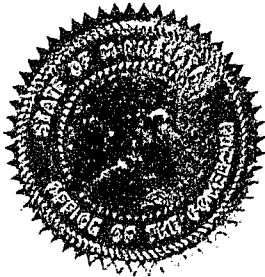
WHEREAS: The current president of DHIA in Stearns County is Melvin Kunstleben; and
