- WHEREAS: The criminal justice system cannot achieve justice and fairness without recognizing and upholding the innate rights of the victims and witnesses of crime; and
- WHEREAS: It is imperative that victims and witnesses of crime have confidence that their rights will be upheld; and
- WHEREAS: Significant legislation and policy have been enacted in Minnesota in recent years to improve the responsiveness of the criminal justice system to the concerns of victims of crime; and
- WHEREAS: The involvement of concerned citizens and leaders in the public and private sectors is required to continue providing quality services in Minnesota which assist crime victims and witnesses; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota reaffirms its commitment to ensure the rights of crime victims and witnesses; and
- WHEREAS: National Victims' Rights Week is being observed the second week of April, 1989;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 9, 1989 through April 15, 1989 to be

MINNESOTA VICTIMS' RIGHTS WEEK


in Minnesota.


