WHEREAS: James Dean Howden was born in Austin, Minnesota on July 1, 1932; and

WHEREAS: Mr. James Dean Howden graduated from Austin High School and joined the United States Navy, thereby starting his 37 year government career; and

WHEREAS: In 1956, James Dean Howden joined the Civil Aviation Administration as an air traffic controller; and

WHEREAS: Mr. James Dean Howden has been a manager of the Albuquerque and Fort Worth Air Route Traffic Control Centers during his career; and
