WHEREAS: The breed of horses known as Morgan was directly responsible for civilizing this land; and

WHEREAS: Our Calvary Remount Program would not have succeeded without the Morgan influence; and

WHEREAS: The horse industry to this day is a vital segment of the economy of this state; and

WHEREAS: The Morgan is the only registered breed of horse ever perpetuated by the United States government; and

WHEREAS: 1989 is the Bicentennial year of the Morgan Horse; and

WHEREAS: The North Central Morgan Association will sponsor a week of Morgan activities July 9-15, 1989; and

WHEREAS: The North Star Charity Morgan show is held on behalf of Children's Cancer Research Foundation - University of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 9 through July 15, 1989 to be

MINNESOTA MORGAN HORSE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe this week with appropriate activities giving special attention to the contributions of the Morgan breed to Minnesota.
