WHEREAS: Language is the major instrument of human expression and provides the communication between people which is the key to world harmony; and

WHEREAS: The world community is brought closer together as each person grows in appreciation for and understanding of another person's language; and

WHEREAS: A special time should be set aside each year for emphasis on learning foreign languages and cultures;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March of 1990 to be

FOREIGN LANGUAGE MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all our citizens to consider the importance of learning foreign languages so that we might better know our neighbors throughout the world.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
