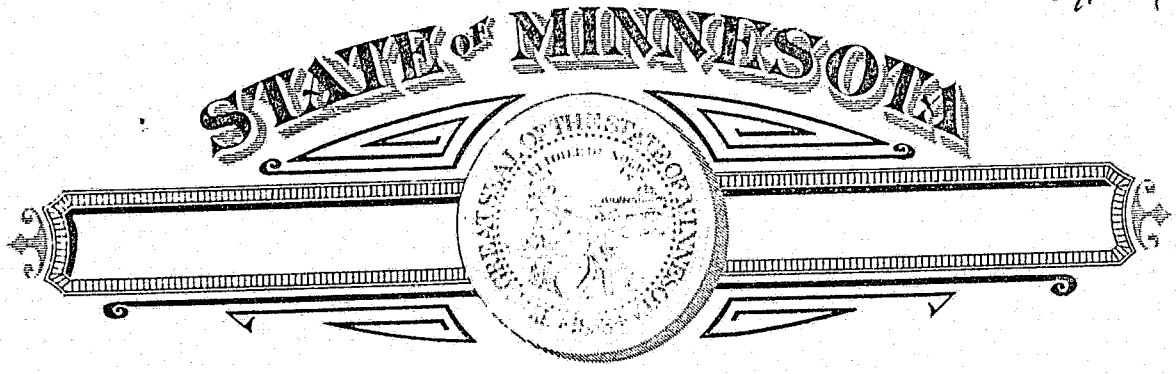

Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Senator Florian Chmielewski, of Sturgeon Lake, Minnesota, has been entertaining and delighting audiences with his accordion music for 45 years; and
- WHEREAS: Florian's musical career began when his brother Chester offered him his accordion if he promised to learn to play it within three months; and
- WHEREAS: Ninety days later, Florian had not only learned to play the accoraian, but had formed a two-piece polka band and was scheduled to play at a wedding dance in Sturgeon Lake; and
- WHEREAS: Since that time, Florian has accomplished much in his career as an accordion player, including starting a Polish TV Party on Channel 6, WDSM Duluth, with his four brothers in 1955; and
- WHEREAS: Pat Cadigan and Loren Lindiveg later joined the band, and this group produced over 1,650 TV shows seen on 40 channels nation-wide, and became the nation's largest running polka TV show ever produced; and
- WHEREAS: During his musical career Florian has made over 9,000 public appearances, and has been on stage with Lawrence Welk, Myron Floren, and Hank Williams, Sr.; and
- WHEREAS: On Sunday, February 4, "Chmielewski Appreciation Day" will be held at the Embassy Club in Sturgeon Lake, with a dinner, and a dance featuring the music of the Chmielewski Funtime Band, in honor of all of Florian's musical contributions to the State of Minnesota;

in Minnesota.

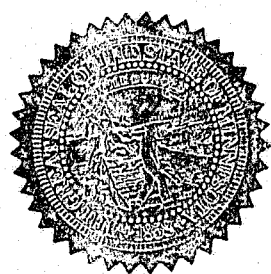
