- WHEREAS: As a musical producer, songwriter, performer, conductor, composer, lecturer and recording artist, Gary Hines, of Minneapolis, has shown his dedication to the musical profession, and his exceptional talent in many different ways; and
- WHEREAS: Gary has also contributed much to his community and to the State of Minnesota through his involvement in numerous important musical projects; and
- WHEREAS: Gary is the producer/director/songwriter for the "Sounds of Blackness" which was the 1989 winner of the Minnesota Music Academy Award; and
- WHEREAS: Gary's recent performances include the Minnesota Opera production of "Salome"; the University of Minnesota - Martin Luther King Annual Concert; a performance with Prince and Sheila E. at the Met Sports Center in 1988, and "Thanksgiving Gospel Celebration" at the Ordway Music Theatre in 1988, which he also produced and arranged; and
- WHEREAS: Gary wrote, produced, directed and conducted the orchestra for the 1989 Minnesota Black Musicians and Artists Awards program; and
- WHEREAS: Gary arranged and conducted the background vocals for the "Batman" movie theme, and recorded with Prince and Sheila E. at Paisley Park Studios; and
