



## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Minnesota Women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and
- WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and
- WHEREAS: Linda Berglin is a Minnesota state legislator who has left a significant mark in both the House and the Senate; her career as a public official has involved tireless dedication to ensuring and furthering the human dignity of all peoples of our state; and
- WHEREAS: Linda Berglin was elected to the Minnesota House of Representatives in 1972, and was re-elected in 1974, 1976, and 1978; during this period she chaired the Health Subcommittee of the Health and Welfare Committee, and the Income and Sales Tax Division of the House Tax Committee; and
- WHEREAS: She was the chairperson of the Council on the Economic Status of Women, and was the first woman Assistant Majority Leader in Minnesota;
- WHEREAS: Since 1980, Linda Berglin has served as State Senator for District 60 in Minneapolis; she chairs the Health and Human Services Committee, and is the first woman to chair a full committee in the Minnesota State Senate;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim
