WHEREAS: Black, Indian, Hispanic, and Asian women provide significant leadership and contribution in promoting the quality of life in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Black, Indian, Hispanic and Asian women have received inadequate recognition for their endeavors; and

WHEREAS: March is observed as Women's History Month; and

WHEREAS: March 1 has been designated as Women of Color Recognition Day by the National Institute for Women of Color; and

WHEREAS: The Women of Color Recognition Day will raise public awareness about the leadership and contribution of Black, Indian, Hispanic, and Asian women in Minnesota;
