GOVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 18.


Extending Additional Protection to Deer in Todd, Redwood,
Renville and Yellow Medicine Counties.

Whereas, it has been represented to the Commis-
sioner of Game and Fish that deer are in danger of undue
depletion in the counties of Todd, Redwood, Renville and
Yellow Medicine, and,


Whereas, the Commissioner of Game and Fish has
investigated and has presented me with the result of his
investigation and has recommended that protection be given
deer in Todd, Redwood, Renville and Yellow Medicine Counties
to prevent their undue depletion,

Now, Therefore, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor
of the State of Minnesota, by virtue and pursuant to authority
in me vested by Section 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order
that no deer be taken from the counties of Todd, Redwood,
Renville and Yellow Medicine, State of Minnesota, during
the season of 1928.

This order shall remain in force until the close
of the 1929 regular session of the legislature, State of
Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
