RESOLUTION FOR HOLDING AN ELECTION.

APRIL 14, 1921.

Commissioner Seberger offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:-

WHEREAS, a petition signed by ten legal voters residing within the territory described as follows, to-wit:

1. All that part of Government Lots 1 and 2, in Section 24, Twp. 124 N. R. 28 W. described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section 24, 60 ft. East of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner thereof, thence East on said North line of Section 24, a distance of 1595 ft. to the West line of G.N. Railway Co. right of way, along the spur track to the Tileston Mill, so-called, now the Great Northern Milling Company Mills, thence S'ly. and SW'ly, along said right of way line to its intersection with a line 165 ft. No. of and parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2, thence West on a line parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2, a distance of 693 ft. to the W'ly. line of said Section 24, thence North along the W. line of Section 24 to its intersection with the No. line of Lot 6, Block 9, Residence Park Addition to the City of St. Cloud, thence E. along the No. line of said Lot 6, a distance of 60 ft. thence North on a line parallel with the West line of Section 24, to the point of beginning.

2. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Block 1, Residence Park Addition.

3. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, Block 8, Residence Park Addition.

4. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 9, Residence Park Addition.

5. The No. 132 ft. of W. 53 ft. of Government Lot 1, Section 24, Twp. 124, N.R. 28 West.

6. The E'ly. 7 ft. of the W'ly. 60 ft. of the N'ly. 8 rods of Section 24, Twp. 124 No. R. 28 West.

7. The E'ly. 60 ft. of 16th and 17th streets South in Residence Park Addition to the City of St. Cloud and 7 foot alley abutting Blocks 1, 8 and 9 on the East, has been presented to this Commission, asking that the above described territory be annexed to the City of St. Cloud, which it adjoins, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, considers it appropriate and desirable to submit the question of such annexation to the voters of said territory,

above described, at a time and place hereinafter designated, as provided by the Laws of Minnesota in Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Sections 1845 to 1849 inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota, that said petition be duly filed, and that notice be given for holding the election to determine the question of said annexation, which election is to be held on Tuesday, the 28th day of April, 1931, between 3:00 and 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon, at the office of St. Cloud Orphanage, located within said territory above described; and that notice, with a copy of said petition, be posted in three public places within such territory described, to-wit, one at the main entrance to the office building of said St. Cloud Orphanage, one on Telephone pole near N.W. corner of building and one on Telephone pole westerly of Office building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Edward Mahowald, William Ohnsorg and Joseph A. Wey, be, and they hereby are appointed three inspectors to act as judges of said election, and conduct the same, and that these judges be authorized and directed to appoint a clerk for said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT the ballot to be used at said election shall read as follows:

Your petitioners respectfully represent that they are legal voters residing within the territory described as follows, to-wit:

1. All that part of Government Lots 1 and 2, in Section 24, Twp. 124 N. R. 28 W. described as follows: Beginning at a point on the North line of said Section 24, 60 ft. East of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner thereof, thence East on said North line of Section 24, a distance of 1595 ft. to the West line of G. N. Railway Co. right of way, along the spur track to the Tileston Mill, so-called, now the Great Northern Milling Co. mills, thence S'ly. and SW'ly. along said right of way line to its intersection with a line 165 ft. No. of and parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2, thence West on a line parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2, a distance of 693 ft. to the W'ly. line of said Section 24, thence North along the W. line of Section 24 to its intersection with the No. line of Lot 6, Block 9, Residence Park Addition to the City of St. Cloud, thence E along the No. line of said Lot 6, a distance of 60 ft. thence North on a line parallel with the West line of Section 24, to the point of beginning.

2. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Block 1, Residence Park Addition.

3. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, Block 8, Residence Park Addition.

4. The easterly 53 ft. of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 9, Residence Park Addition.

5. The No. 132 ft. of W. 53 ft. of Government Lot 1, Section 24, Twp. 124 N. R. 28 West.

6. The E'ly. 7 ft. of the W'ly. 60 ft. of the N'ly. 8 rods of Section 24, Twp. 124 No. R. 28 West.

7. The E'ly. 60 ft. of 16th and 17th Streets South in Residence Park Addition to the City of St. Cloud and 7 foot alley abutting Blocks 1, 3 and 9 on the East.

That said territory contains a population of over seventy five persons, and adjoins the City of St. Cloud, but is not included within the limits of said City, and that no part of said territory is more than one and a half miles from the present limits of said City of St. Cloud. That your petitioners have caused to be taken, a census of the resident population of said territory, above described, and that it shows a population of more than seventy five persons, the population being 95 persons. That said census was taken within four weeks last past. That there are 68.56 acres embraced in said territory above described, and that the boundaries of said territory are as follows: All that part of Government Lots 1 and 2 in Section 24 Twp. 124 No. R. 28 W. described as follows: Beginning at the N. W. cor of said Section 24 thence E. on the North line of said Section 24 a distance of 1655 ft. to the West line of the Great Northern Ry. Co. Rt. of Way along the Spur track to the Tileston Mill so-called, now the Great Northern Milling Company's Mills thence S'ly. and SW'ly. along said Right of Way line to its intersection with a line 165 ft. No. of and parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2 thence West on a line parallel with the So. line of Government Lot 2 a distance of 693 ft. to the W'ly. line of said Section 24 thence N. along the West line of Section 24 to the point of beginning.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray that the governing body of the city of St. Cloud call an election for the determination of the annexation of the territory, above described, to the city of St. Cloud.
