

COPY OF RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULT OF ELECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO, IN THE COUNTY OF WRIGHT AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, ON THE QUESTION OF REINCORPORATION UNDER THE REVISED LAWS OF 1905.

Be it resolved that, whereas on the 15th day of August, 1905, a Special Election was duly had, as provided in Section 699 of the Revised Laws of 1905, to vote on the proposition whether the Village of Buffalo, in Wright County, Minnesota, should reincorporate under the Revised Laws of 1905; and whereas there were sixty-five votes cast at such election in favor of such reincorporation and eight votes ~~XXXX~~ ^{cast} ~~XXXX~~ against such reincorporation, the said proposition to reincorporate is hereby declared carried and the Village Recorder is hereby ordered to file a certified copy of this resolution with the County Auditor of said Wright County, Minnesota, and with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and that upon the filing of such certified copies, the said Village of Buffalo is hereby declared reincorporated under the Revised Laws of 1905.
