

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF GENEVA BRAZIL FOR THE DETACH-
MENT OF LANDS FROM THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE AND ANNEXING SAME TO
THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON LAKE.

The above entitled matter came on duly to be heard by and
before the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Sibley and
State of Minnesota, at a meeting ^{of} said Board held on the 20th. day of
Feb'y. 1935 at two o'clock P.M. pursuant to adjournment of said hearing
had on January 8th. 1935 upon the petition of Geneva Brazil and others
praying that the following lands lying and being in the County of
Sibley and State of Minnesota described as follows, to-wit:-

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the
Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Eighteen (18)
Township One Hundred Fourteen (114), North of
Range Twenty-six (26) West, thence running West
Eighty (80) Rods, thence South Twenty-four (24)
Rods, thence East Eighty (80) Rods, thence running
North Twenty-four (24) rods to point of begin-
ing, containing Twelve (12) acres

be detached from the Village of Green Isle in said County and be
annexed to the Township of Washington Lake in said County.

The Board having heard all interested parties and considered
all matters pertaining to the petition and it appearing, that a majority
of the legal voters of both the Village of Green Isle and the Town-
ship of Washington Lake signed said petition, that it is for the best
interests of said Village and said Township and the owners of said lands

that the same be detached from said Village and annexed to said Township, that the notices of hearing and all other requirements have been given and had according to law, that the land described in said petition may be ~~be~~ detached from said Village of Green Isle without unreasonably affecting the symmetry of the settled portion thereof, and that said tracts of land are so conditioned as not properly to be subjected to Village Government, and that said land is not necessary for the reasonable exercise of the Police powers and other functions of said Village of Green Isle.

As conclusions the Board finds that the petitioner is entitled to the order of this Board detaching said land described in said petition from the said Village of Green Isle and annexing same to the Township of Washington Lake

Now therefore, it is ordered, adjusted and decreed that said lands be, and the same hereby are detached from the Village of Green Isle and annexed to the Township of Washington Lake.
