WRIT OF ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN THE  
OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR FROM THE FIFTY-  
SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE,  
AND OF SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO NOMI-  
NATE CANDIDATES FOR SAID OFFICE.

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of  
the Fifty-seventh Senatorial District of said State; to  
the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; to the  
County Auditors of the Counties of St. Louis, Lake and  
Cook of said State; to all Election Officials of said Fifty-  
seventh Senatorial District and of the several Election  
Districts therein; and to all Others Whom it may Concern -  
GREETINGS:

WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of State  
Senator from the fifty-seventh senatorial district of the State  
of Minnesota caused by the death of the late State Senator,  
the Honorable Charles E. Adams; and


WHEREAS there has not been and will not be any  
Session of the Legislature between the happening of said  
vacancy and the next general election;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Hjalmar Peterson, as Governor  
of the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and  
direction of Section 17 of Article 4 of the Constitution of  
this State and the statutes in such case provided, DO HEREBY  
DIRECT that the vacancy now existing in said office be filled  
at the next general election to be held in said senatorial  
district on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 1936; that  
candidates for said office be nominated at a special primary  
election to be held on Monday, the 26th day of October, 1936;



that affidavits of candidates for nomination at said special primary election shall be filed not later than the seventh day before the primary, to-wit, not later than October 19th, 1936; that notices of said election and the special primary therefor, the nomination and election of candidates, and the conduct of said elections be had and all things pertaining thereto be done as provided by Laws 1929, Chapter 297, and amendments thereof, and other applicable provisions of law.
