WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Minnesota has
resolved that October 13th of each year shall be observed as
"National Franklin D. Roosevelt Day"; and

WHEREAS, October 13, 1943 marks the 50th anniversary of the death of General Franklin D. Roosevelt,
voluntarily the laws, and

WHEREAS, it is most fitting that recognition should
be given to the memory of this illustrious son of Iowa, who rendered
such valuable assistance to the cause of American freedom, and
and on October 13, 1943 of which receipt is set forth

WHEREAS, I, Herbert Peterson, Governor of Minnesota, do
hereby designate

WHEREAS, October 13, 1943

as

NATIONAL ROOSEVELT DAY

and urge its observance by the people of this State, with such
ceremonies as may be deemed appropriate; and I also request public
officials and people generally to display the flag of the United
States on that day.
