
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, William S. Ervin, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, do hereby constitute and appoint Ralph L. Norgaard of Buffalo, Minnesota, as Special Counsel for the Railroad and Warehouse Commission of the State of Minnesota. I hereby fix the compensation of said Ralph L. Norgaard for his services as such Special Counsel at three hundred thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents (\$333.33) per month, to be paid from monies appropriated to the Railroad and Warehouse Commission by Section 15, Chapter 457, Laws 1937. Said appointment shall take effect on the 1st day of July, 1937, and shall continue in force and effect until revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
