

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, and particularly by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 114, and upon the request of Walter S. Olson, Director of the Division of Water Resources and Engineering, and of W. L. Strunk, Commissioner of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint C. D. O'Brien III of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Counsel for the Division of Water Resources and Engineering of the Department of Conservation and for the Department of Conservation, to render legal services to such state agencies. Said appointment shall commence upon September 15, 1942, and shall continue until terminated by law or at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The compensation for said services shall be the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month, said compensation to be paid from funds available for that purpose to the Division of Water Resources and Engineering and to the Department of Conservation.


