W H E R E A S , thousands of Minnesota men and women are now serving
in the United States Marine Corps, and

W H E R E A S , Minnesotans have done much to add to the outstanding
record of the Corps on land, at sea and in the air,
and

W H E R E A S , the Marine Corps is now preparing to observe its
100th birthday,

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
do hereby proclaim

November 5th to 10th, 1943,

as

"TELL IT TO THE MARINES"
WEEK

in which the citizens of Minnesota will be called upon to participate
in civic activities "telling" the Marines of our appreciation for
what the Corps has done, in this war and in others, as well as in
peace.

Capitol in St. Paul, this 1st
day of November, 1943.
