That on the 26th day of June, 1945, public hearing was held at McIntosh, in Polk County, after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 17th day of December, 1945, the State Soil Conservation

Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for including the additional territory within the East Polk Soil Conservation District and did define the boundaries of such additional territory;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of inclusion of said territory within the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the 21st day of January, 1946;




