

House File No. 501. "An act to appropriate money for the erection of an additional building at the State Reform School, insurance and repairs".

The item making an appropriation for the erection of an additional building for the boys department of the State Reform School, Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), Disapproved.

I deem it my duty to seek to limit the obligations of the treasury to its probable resources. I regret that in the discharge of that duty, I am compelled to deprive this most deserving institution of present means for increasing its usefulness.

The other items of appropriation are approved.
