# **ERER Task Force - Phase I County Status Reports**

### Pilot County Workgroup Meeting – April 13, 2004

- Counties discussed cross-validations between e-recording system and indexing systems to validate mortgage numbers and dates for Satisfactions.
- An issue to be reviewed by the legal committee was raised concerning the requirement of a Drafted By Party on all electronically submitted documents.
- Roseau County
  - All software is installed
  - WCI is working through issues with documents submitted from Ingeo.
- Dakota County
  - o 2715 documents electronically recorded
  - Trying to move forward on Assignment of Mortgage, but no submitters at this point.
- Lyon County
  - o 39 documents electronically recorded
  - Working on a letter of intent from Ingeo so that a bank account can be set up for deposits.
- Hennepin County
  - Working on cross validations between electronically recorded documents and their indexing system (matching mortgage numbers and dates)
  - Conducting user acceptance testing with test documents and working through issues.
  - Plan to start e-recording 5 to 10 documents at first to be sure that e-recording system is working as planned.

#### Standards Evaluation Status

- Dakota County(Fidlar) has been validated for the Assignment of Mortgage.
- Skytek has begun the validation for Assignment of Mortgage for Hennepin County.
- Ingeo/Renville is still performing internal testing on SAT's and COR's. They have been provided a sample of the SKYTEK test suite prior to beginning validation testing. Skytek is still waiting to begin validation of SAT's and COR's at Renville.
- No updates have been made to the Yahoo OO group website. Skytek continues to work with counties to receive feedback.
- Skytek has contacted the Department of Health to discuss how the Well Disclosure Certificate will be handled in the future.

Encountered a challenge when working with Parcel Id Number (PIN) coming in with a document. We are requiring the submitter to data enter the document number or book and page of the Mortgage that is being satisfied. The property that has been mortgaged could have multiple PIN numbers and it is a challenge to link multiple PIN numbers with legal descriptions on the back end tract index. We are going to require a PIN, but we will only index the PINs that were previously recorded with the original mortgage that is being satisfied.
