Agency Purpose

he 2003 legislature moved the licensing responsibilities for cosmetologists from the Commerce Department, to the Barbers Examiners Board, and renamed it the Board of Barber and Cosmetologist Examiners. The merger took effect in FY 2005. Currently, M.S. 154, and 155A, and MN Rules 2100,

At A Glance

Factors affecting the board are school enrollment and the number of individuals, shops, and schools that are licensed on an annual basis.

2642, and 2644 authorized the board to examine barbers and cosmetologists.

Core Functions

The combined board is responsible for the following:

- administering examinations;
- regulating the practice and registration of all barbers, cosmetologists, shops, and schools; and
- conducting inspections of shops and schools on an annual basis to ensure that all sanitary statutes and rules
 are complied with. As a result of these inspections, the public can be assured of a clean and sanitary
 environment.

Operations

The board's operations for the most part directly affect the licensees, however, the public also can be affected by the processing of complaints and receiving of information. Services are delivered through examinations, licensing, inspections, regulation, processing of complaints, and giving information to individuals requesting it.

Budget

The combined board's FY 2005 budget totaled \$699,000. After the consolidation, the board expects to have three full time inspectors and five full time office personnel. The board is funded with a General Fund appropriation, and recovers all its operating costs through examination and license fees.
