RE: Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary, or Duplicative Rules

This report is submitted pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.05, subd. 5, which provides that agencies report any rules or portions of rules that are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative, as well as the status of rules identified in last year's report as obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative.

The Department of Corrections (DOC) continues its review of Minnesota Rule 2940 related to those portions related to revocation of supervised release.

Minnesota Rule 2920 related to adult halfway houses is currently under review for proposed repeal and replacement. This proposal has been submitted to the Governor's Office and a Request for Comments is currently under development for publication in the *State Register*.
