As requested, according to MS 125A.62, Subd. 8, listed below are the competitive grants that were awarded to the Minnesota State Academies for FY09-FY10.

Affinity Plus Foundation (\$5,000) Grant to provide education to students at the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf learning and utilizing functional monetary and budgeting skills.

Qwest Foundation (\$5,000) Grant to purchase classroom technology for the special needs of the students at the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf.

Mille Lac Band of Ojibwa (\$1,000) Grant to purchase 4 Elmo Document Cameras and 4 LCD projectors to be used in classrooms at the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf in order to enhance students' assistive technology usage.

Women's Sport Foundation (\$4,260) Grant to provide aerobic instruction for young girls at both the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf and the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind.

Target Foundation (\$1,000) Grant to provide cultural experiences for the students at the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind.

Toyota Foundation (\$2,500) Grant to provide alternative teaching and learning for the students at the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf.

MN Dept of Public Safety (\$523.72) Grant to purchase car seats for students at the Minnesota State Academies.

Minnesota Twins (\$1,000) Grant to repair the softball field located on the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf campus.

Minnesota Department of Education (\$15,309) Grant to replace a dishwasher at the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind.

Jordan Foundation (\$5,000) Grant to provide additional instruction for students at the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf who have been unsuccessful in mainstreaming within the community, home and classroom.
