**1998 Appropriation Language**

A. Legal Citation: ML1998, Chapter 404 ,Section 7

**Subd. 3.** Statewide Asset Preservation and State Park and Recreation Area Building Rehabilitation \$6,500,000

For repair and renovation of the Department of Natural Resources land, buildings, or other improvements of a capital nature throughout the state, and to design, repair, rehabilitate, construct or add to state park buildings throughout the state, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**Subd. 4.** State Park and Recreation Area Building Development \$5,535,000

To design, construct, furnish, and equip new buildings and associated utilities in the state park system, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A.

**Subd. 5.** State Park and Recreation Area Betterment and Rehabilitation \$2,750,000

To upgrade, repair, or rehabilitate improvements of a capital nature at state park and recreation area facilities throughout the state, including, but not limited to, resource management projects, trail rehabilitation, road and bridge repair. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**Subd. 6.** State Park and Recreation Area Acquisition \$2,250,000

For acquisition from willing sellers of private lands within state parks and recreation area boundaries established by law. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**1997 Appropriation Language:**

A. Legal Citation: ML1997, Chap. 216, Sec.15, Subd. 4(a)

This appropriation is from the trust fund to the Commissioner of Natural Resources as follows:

(1) For state park and recreation area acquisition \$2,500,000; and (2) for state park and recreation area development, rehabilitation and resource management, \$1,000,000 unless otherwise specified in the approved work program.

The use of the Minnesota conservation Corps is encouraged. The Commissioner must submit grant request for supplemental funding for Federal ISTEA money in eligible categories and report the results to the Legislative Commission on Minnesota resources. This project must be completed and final products delivered by June 30, 2000, and the appropriation is available until that date.

**1996 Appropriation Language:**

A. Legal Citation: ML1996, Chap. 406, Sec. 8 Subd. 3(b) \$1,000,000

State Park and Recreation Area Acquisition.

This appropriation is from the Trust Fund to the Commissioner of Natural Resources for acquisition of land within the statutory boundaries of state parks and recreation areas.

Legal Citation: ML1996 Chap. 463. Sec.7, Subd. 5

State Park and Recreation Area Building Rehabilitation \$2,400,000

For improvements of a capital nature to repair, rehabilitate, construct, or add to state park buildings throughout the state, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**Subd. 6.** State Park and Recreation Area Building Development \$1,750,000

To construct, furnish, and equip new buildings and associated utilities in the state park system, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A. \$500,000 of this amount is for an Interpretive Center at Lake Bronson State Park. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**Subd. 7.** State Park and Recreation Area Betterment and Rehabilitation \$1,450,000

To upgrade, repair, or rehabilitate improvements of a capital nature at state park and recreation area facilities throughout the state, including, but not limited to, resource management projects, trail rehabilitation, campground rehabilitation, and road and bridge repair. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**Subd. 8.** State Park and Recreation Area Acquisition \$1,750,000

For acquisition from willing sellers of private lands within state park and recreation area boundaries established by law. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need.

**1995 Appropriation Language:**

M.L. 1995, Chapter 220, Section 19, Subd. 4(b)

State Park and Recreation Acquisition, Development, Betterment and Rehabilitation. This appropriation is from the Trust Fund to the Commissioner of Natural Resources as follows: (1) for state park and recreation area acquisition, \$1,070,000 of which up to \$670,000 may be used for state trail acquisition of a critical nature; (2) for state park and recreation development \$680,000 and; (3) for betterment and rehabilitation of state parks and recreation areas \$1,400,000. The use of the Minnesota Conservation Corps is encouraged in the rehabilitation and development, \$1,384,000 of this appropriation is from the Trust Fund acceleration. The Commissioner must submit grant requests for supplemental funding for Federal ISTE money in eligible categories and report the results to the Legislative Commission on Minnesota Resources. This project must be completed and final products delivered by December 31, 1997, and the appropriation is available until that date.

M.L. 1995, Chapter 220, Section 19, Subd. (J) Upper Sioux Agency State Park. This appropriation to the Commissioner of Natural Resources is from the Future Resources Fund for bathroom and shower facilities at Upper Sioux Agency State Park. \$ 200,000

M.L. 1995, Chapter 220, Section 20. Additional Appropriations. (a) state park and recreation area acquisition. This appropriation is to the Commissioner of Natural Resources acquisition of land within the statutory boundaries of state park and recreation areas. \$1,120,000

M.L. 1994, Chapter 643, Section 23, Subd. 4. State Park Building Rehabilitation. For improvements of a capital nature to repair, rehabilitate, construct, or add to state park buildings throughout the state, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need \$2,000,000

M.L. 1994, Chapter 643, Section 23, Subd. 5. State Park Building Development. To construct, furnish, and equip new facilities in the state park system, according to the management plan required in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 86A. This includes shower and toilet facilities, visitor contact stations, and storage facilities. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need. \$1,000,000

M.L. 1994, Chapter 643, Section 23, Subd. 11. State Park Betterment and Rehabilitation. To upgrade, repair, or rehabilitate improvements of a capital nature at state park facilities throughout the state but not limited to campsite improvements, trail resurfacing, road repair and resurfacing, parking area improvements, utility systems upgrades, erosion control, lakeshore stabilization, and prairie restoration. The Commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need. \$1,250,000

M.L. 1994, Chapter 643, Section 23, Subd. 25. State Park Acquisition. To acquire from willing sellers private lands within park boundaries established by law. The commissioner shall determine project priorities as appropriate based upon need. \$2,000,000

## II. PROJECT SUMMARY AND RESULTS:

This project includes the major rehabilitation and development of state park and recreation area buildings, structures and utility systems and the rehabilitation and betterment of non-building facilities such as trails, roads, campgrounds and resources. Also included, is the acquisition of lands within the boundaries of state park and recreation areas from willing sellers.

Results of the 1998 appropriation will include the acquisition of private lands within the statutory boundaries of state parks as listed in column I of the attached chart. Results will also include the development and rehabilitation of state park buildings, campgrounds, trails, roads, and other facilities as listed in column F, G and H of the attached chart.

Individual projects are prioritized using a project evaluation process. Projects are developed at the park level and rated by the park and regional managers. The projects are then prioritized statewide based on the combined rating.

V. CONTEXT:

A. Significance: This project will contribute toward preserving the significant architectural and cultural resources represented by the hundreds of CCC/WPA buildings in the state park system. It will also bring many structures and utility systems up to current building, ADA, electrical and sewage treatment requirements. New facilities will be developed to provide services to state park users and unique resources will be protected from development by purchasing state park inholding.

B. Time: Projects will be engineered and constructed as expeditiously as possible. All projects funded with 1997 Trust Fund dollars will be completed by December 31, 2000. All projects funded with 1998 bonding dollars will be completed by December of 2001.
