




An after-the-fact damages award from a lawsuit against the State of Minnesota for arbitrarily denying the permits necessary for Liberty to remain in operation will not adequately compensate Liberty. Customer goodwill, loyal staff, and continued support of the community with revenues from the operations cannot be replaced once lost. The loss is irreparable. A damages award will not adequately compensate Liberty for this loss.

11. I therefore request that the State of Minnesota protect my rights by funding the clerical staff necessary to issue buyer's cards.
