Dear Ms. LaFleur:

Minn. Stat. 525.5-119 requires that the Supreme Court establish a statewide registration system for court guardians and conservators. The statute also provides that the system must be completed by July 1, 2013, and that the State Court Administrator "shall report to the legislature on the fees or other source of funds to support the costs of developing and administering the registration system by January 1, 2012." I write in response to the report requirement.

The statewide registration system is in the early development stage. At this time, we do not believe there is a need to establish a fee or to seek funding to develop and administer the registration system.
