I. Status of rules identified as obsolete in 2006:

The department identified no obsolete rules in 2006.

II. Obsolete, unnecessary and duplicative rules for 2007

1505.0010-1505.0600: The authorizing legislation was repealed in 2007.

1505.0752; 1505.0754, subp. 2; 1505.0756, subp. 2: These parts are obsolete because they pertain to a section of the authorizing legislation that has been repealed.

1510.0330: This part is obsolete because it refers to an outdated labeling system no longer required by statute

1562.0700, subp. 2; 1562.0800: Both of these parts conflict with current fees and limits set in statute.

The department intends to repeal these parts in January, 2008 using the process for repealing obsolete rules in M.S., sec. 14.3895. Please call me if you have any questions.
