I. Status of rules identified as obsolete in 2008:

II. Obsolete, unnecessary and duplicative rules for 2009:

1505.0730-1505.0750: These parts reference categories and definitions that were removed from the noxious weed law when it was amended in 2009.

1505.1300-1505.1450: These amendments refer to disposal of foreign refuse which is no longer a responsibility of the department. Theses activities are now conducted by USDA APHIS as part of their regulation of interstate and international movement of potential pests.
