Dear Ms. Timmons:

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 14.05, subdivision 5, the Minnesota Board of Dentistry is required to submit to your office by December 1 of each year a list identifying any rules that are obsolete and should be repealed. The statute also requires an explanation of why the rules are obsolete and our timetable for repealing the rules. Listed below are the rules that the Minnesota Board of Dentistry has determined to be obsolete and the applicable reason.

1. Minnesota Rules 3100.0300, subpart 2: The entire subpart should be repealed because it conflicts with the Open Meeting Law (Minnesota Statutes section 471.705).
2. Minnesota Rules 3100.1100, subpart 1, item D: The opening clause "Beginning January 1, 1993," should be repealed because this date has passed.
3. Minnesota rules 3100.1100, subpart 6: The opening clause "Beginning January 1, 1993," should be repealed because this date has passed.
4. Minnesota Rules 3100.3600, subpart 2, item A: The opening clause "Beginning January 1, 1993," should be repealed because this date has passed.
5. Minnesota Rules 3100.3600, subpart 3, item A: The opening clause "Beginning January 1, 1993, should be repealed because this date has passed.

The Board has identified the above five rules over the past few years as obsolete. The Board has intended to attach these rules to a non-controversial rulemaking effort; however, the Board has not initiated any rulemaking since these rules were identified as obsolete. Although the Board approved an Authorizing Resolution on December 10, 1999, allowing for rulemaking to begin earlier this year, rulemaking has not yet begun.
