I. Status of rules identified as obsolete in 2010 and 2011:

The repeal of the rules identified as obsolete in 2010 was included in the department's 2011 omnibus bill. The bill did not pass before the end of 2011 session, but the rule repeal was included in a bill that passed in 2012: Laws of Minnesota 2012, Chapter 244, article 1, section 83. No additional rules were identified as obsolete in 2011

II. Obsolete, unnecessary and duplicative rules for 2012:

1505.0751, subps 7 and 8. These subparts duplicate language in statute and are unnecessary.
