Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary or Duplicative Rules as Required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 14.05, Subdivision 5

Dear Governor Dayton, Legislative Coordinating Commission, Senators, Representatives, and Revisor Timmons:

Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs the Board of Cosmetologist Examiners (BCE) to report to you by December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.

The Board of Cosmetologist Examiners has previously declared its intention to amend or repeal obsolete rules. That process began in January, 2013 and continues to be underway. BCE has reviewed its rules and found no others that have become obsolete, unnecessary or duplicative over the course of the last year.
