Dear Chairs and Leads of the Health and Human Services Committees,

As you know, the legislature required the Commissioner to raise the MinnesotaCare premiums sufficient to raise \$27.8 million in the biennium ending June 30, 2017. In my June 23rd letter, I provided to you the proposed premiums in order to meet this legislative requirement outlined in Laws of Minnesota 2015, chapter 71, article 11, section 57.

I am writing now to let you know that we have finalized the following premiums that will go into effect August 1, 2015. The final premiums below match the proposed premiums that we shared in my previous letter.

The legislation also directed the Commissioner to provide statutory language to codify the revised premium scale in statute. Below you will find the language necessary to accomplish this.

256L.15, subd. 2 (d) The following premium scale is established for each individual in the household who is 21 years of age or older and enrolled in MinnesotaCare:
